● INFORMATION ABOUT MAGNETS

As part of holistic development activities at Sneha Foundation, children were given information about magnets on 17 January 2026. A magnet is an object that attracts metals such as iron and nickel. A magnet has two poles—north and south. Like poles repel each other, while unlike poles attract each other; this phenomenon is known as magnetism.

In addition, children were explained the uses of magnets in daily life, and their effects were demonstrated through experiments. Information about the surrounding magnetic field was also explained in simple language.

Through this activity, scientific thinking, curiosity, and an interest in learning were developed among the children of the institution.



● INFORMATION ABOUT SUBHAS CHANDRA BOSE

As part of holistic development activities at Sneha Foundation, the birth anniversary of **Subhas Chandra Bose** was celebrated on **23 January 2026**. On this occasion, teachers provided children with important information about the life of Subhas Chandra Bose.

Subhas Chandra Bose believed that India could achieve complete independence only through struggle. For this purpose, he established the **Azad Hind Fauj** and inspired soldiers to fight for the nation.

The teacher also explained Bose's thoughts to the children, including his famous slogan, "Give me blood, and I will give you freedom," instilling in them the spirit of sacrifice for the country.

The teacher informed the children about his birth and death and explained that the life of Subhas Chandra Bose continues to be a great source of inspiration for all of us even today.



● MARTYRS' DAY CELEBRATION

On **30 January 2026**, **Martyrs' Day** was observed at **Sneha Foundation**. During the programme, children were given structured information in simple language about the great martyrs of India's freedom struggle. First, the sacrifices of Bhagat Singh and his companions Sukhdev and Rajguru against British rule were explained. Children were also informed why Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel is known as the "Iron Man of India," why Lala Lajpat Rai was called the "Punjab Kesari," and about Bal Gangadhar Tilak's famous slogan, "Swarajya is my birthright and I shall have it."

Finally, the contribution of Bipin Chandra Pal in spreading national awareness and the spirit of independence was explained. Through this programme, children gained a clear understanding of the lives and sacrifices of India's martyrs.



FESTIVAL CELEBRATIONS

● MAKAR SANKRANTI CELEBRATION

On the occasion of the Uttarayan festival, an awareness and sensitization programme was organized at Sneha Foundation. Through a digital board, children were informed about the religious, social, and seasonal significance of Uttarayan. They were also given the message of positivity and new beginnings associated with the Sun's northward movement.

During the festival, guidance was provided on safety precautions, especially regarding the protection of birds injured by kite strings. Information was also shared about methods to rescue injured birds and available helplines.

Through this programme, efforts were made to develop a sense of responsibility, humanity, care for the environment, and love for animals among the children.

● VASANT PANCHAMI CELEBRATION

On **23 January 2026**, Vasant Panchami was celebrated with great joy and enthusiasm at Sneha Foundation. On this occasion, all the children came dressed in yellow attire, creating a festive and cheerful atmosphere throughout the institution.

During the programme, the significance of Vasant Panchami was explained to the children in simple language, and prayers were offered to Goddess Saraswati, the deity of knowledge. Children were also informed about the beginning of the spring season and the importance of education and learning, motivating them towards their studies. Overall, the programme helped increase children's awareness and interest in Indian culture, traditions, and festivals.



ADOLESCENCE

Under the **Adolescence** Project operated by Sneha Foundation, **sanitary pads** were distributed to a total of **139** girls by **Dr. Hardikbhai Khatri**. Due to the regular implementation of this project, all the girls associated with the foundation are now using sanitary pads, which has led to a reduction in infection-related diseases in women and increased awareness among the girls.

● CHILD SAFETY PROGRAMME

On **24 January 2026**, an important safety and awareness programme was organized for the children of **N. P. Mehta Primary School** operated by **Sneha Foundation**. During this programme, the **Abhayam 112 team** explained in a simple and understandable manner what children should do in emergency situations, how to seek help, and how to use the emergency helpline number 112.
