LEARNING CENTER

At the Learning Center of Sneha Foundation, children engage in various educational and co-curricular activities to make learning enjoyable and meaningful. The main focus areas at the center are reading, writing, and arithmetic. Special emphasis is given to language development in Gujarati, Hindi, and English. Along with this, foundational understanding of Science and Social Science is provided. Additionally, awareness about cleanliness and healthy lifestyle is imparted. Children are educated on different subjects through reading materials, visuals, and structured modules.



N. P. MEHTA PRIMARY SCHOOL REPORT

At Sneha Foundation's N. P. Mehta Primary School, following the government's directive, a "Bagless Saturday" was celebrated. As part of this, children were taught basic sewing using buttons and needles. The students participated in this activity with great enthusiasm.

In addition, children were taught how to create beautiful items from waste materials, such as making decorative "Rakhi's" (traditional wristbands). On the occasion of Guru Purnima, children were taught the significance of the Guru. A small ceremony was held with worship of Goddess Sarasvati and Saint Shri Bajrangdas Bapa's idol, followed by distribution of holy offerings (prasad) to the children.







OVERALL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

WOOL CRAFTS

On 5 July 2025, under the overall development initiative at Sneha Foundation, a creative activity was conducted where children enthusiastically created various handicrafts using wool. They artistically prepared items like doormats, door hangings and decorative pieces with wool.

The main objective of this activity was to develop children's creativity and artistic skills. Some students made step decorations while others created various ornamental items using wool.





INFORMATION ABOUT MICROSCOPE

On 19 July 2025, a special educational session on the microscope was held under the overall development program. Children were taught what a microscope is, its purpose, and how it works.

They were given detailed information about the parts of a microscope such as lens, tube, stage, and mirror. Children used microscopes themselves to observe tiny samples and gained hands-on experience. They learned about the importance and application of microscopes in a deeper way.

Additionally, children were taught about leaf cross-sections, including information on various layers like white tissue, xylem, and phloem. The importance of leaves in our life process was explained in detail.

Through such scientific activities, students developed curiosity toward science, enhanced observation skills, and cultivated interest in studies. These activities are part of our continuous effort to foster all-round development in children.





KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS

A special motivational program was organized for Kargil Vijay Diwas, where children were informed about the heroic stories of India's brave soldiers. Teachers explained the 1999 Kargil war with Pakistan and how our courageous soldiers fought with determination and patriotism to win over difficult terrains.

Kargil Vijay Diwas is not just a historic day but a proud occasion symbolizing patriotism, sacrifice, and valor. Children paid tribute to the martyrs by lighting lamps and learned the importance of honoring soldiers and never forgetting their sacrifices.





WORLD TIGER DAY

On the occasion of World Tiger Day, an awareness and information session was organized for children at Sneha Foundation. Teachers explained the different species of tigers, their ecological importance, and the current threat of declining populations in detail. They were told how, despite being fierce hunters, tigers play a vital role in maintaining balance in the ecosystem.

The program emphasized that World Tiger Day is celebrated every year on 29 July, to spread awareness about tiger conservation and encourage efforts to increase their numbers. Through videos and presentations, children learned about the lifestyle of tigers and their economic and environmental significance. Issues like poaching and deforestation were discussed, and children were educated on the importance of preserving natural resources and ensuring safe habitats for tigers.





HEALTH CHECKUP CAMP

On 21 July 2025, a seminar was organized at Sneha Foundation in collaboration with HCG Hospital, especially for teachers. The primary goal was to spread health awareness among educators. Doctors from HCG provided important and information about CPR (Cardiopulmonary practical Resuscitation), including how and when to perform it in emergencies and how timely CPR can save lives.

During the seminar, free BP and blood sugar tests were also conducted for teachers. All teachers actively participated and more conscious about their health. health-oriented programs are becoming highly beneficial and necessary in the field of education. Sneha Foundation and HCG Hospital extend heartfelt thanks to everyone involved in this noble initiative.







ADOLESCENCE

Under the Adolescence Project operated by Sneha Foundation, sanitary pads were distributed to a total of 138 girls by Dr. Hardikbhai Khatri. Due to the regular implementation of this project, all the girls associated with the foundation are now using sanitary pads, which has led to a reduction in infection-related diseases in women and increased awareness among the girls.
