SNEHA FOUNDATION SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A LARGE-SCALE PROJECT BY MAKING MORE THAN 21,000 SEED BALLS.

To protect the environment and create a greener future, Sneha Foundation launched this initiative and successfully produced more than **21,000 seed balls**. Students from **N. P. Mehta Primary School** and internship students from **Government College** enthusiastically participated in the campaign and helped make the project a success.



Place

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During this project, the students gained practical knowledge of the entire seed ball-making process. They prepared the seed balls by using soil, natural fertilizer, and the seeds of various tree species. The team also guided the students on the importance of tree plantation, environmental conservation, biodiversity, and the responsible preservation of natural resources.

Internship students from Government College worked together with the children and demonstrated excellent teamwork, planning, and social responsibility. Through this project, the team not only increased environmental awareness among the children but also encouraged the values of service, cooperation, and love for nature.

The team scattered the prepared seed balls in various locations across Bhavnagar, including Ruvapari Temple, Jhanjhariya Hanumanji Temple, Ruva Village, and Bor Talav. This initiative aimed to help more trees grow and contribute to the creation of a greener environment.

This campaign was more than just a seed ball-making activity. It served as an inspiring initiative to develop a sense of environmental responsibility and sensitivity among the younger generation. LEARNING CENTER

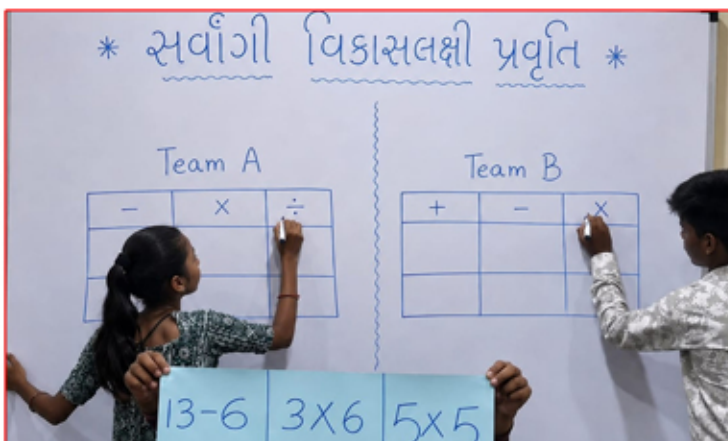


OVERALL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

● IQ TEST-BASED ACTIVITY

On **4 July 2026**, Sneha Foundation organized an **IQ test-based activity** for children as part of its holistic development programme. The activity aimed to strengthen the children's logical reasoning, observation skills, memory, problem-solving abilities, and quick decision-making skills. The facilitators engaged the children with a variety of interesting questions and mental exercises designed to enhance their cognitive development.

The children participated enthusiastically and used their critical thinking skills to answer the questions. These activities helped improve their intellectual development, concentration, self-confidence, and creative thinking. At the end of the session, the team encouraged the children to participate regularly in such developmental activities.



● MONSOON SAFETY AWARENESS

On **18 July 2026**, Sneha Foundation conducted an awareness session to educate children about health, safety, and hygiene during the rainy season. As the risk of seasonal illnesses and accidents increases during the monsoon, the team explained essential safety precautions in simple and easy-to-understand language.

The children were advised to avoid going outdoors during heavy rainfall unless it was absolutely necessary. They were instructed not to use raincoats or umbrellas during thunderstorms because lightning can pose a serious risk. The facilitators explained that getting completely drenched in the rain could lead to illnesses such as colds, coughs, fever, and other infections. If the children became wet in the rain for any reason, they were advised to change into clean, dry clothes immediately after reaching home.

The session also emphasized the importance of drinking safe water. The children were encouraged to drink only clean, boiled, or filtered water and to avoid consuming food sold by street vendors or uncovered food during the rainy season. They were also reminded to wash their hands thoroughly with soap before meals and after using the washroom.

The children were advised not to play or walk through waterlogged roads, potholes, or dirty stagnant water, as these places increase the risk of accidents, skin infections, and other diseases. They were also instructed to stay away from fallen electric wires, damaged poles, and electrical equipment submerged in water.

During thunderstorms, the children were advised not to stand in open playgrounds, under large trees, or near electric poles. They were encouraged to remain in safe places and seek help from elders whenever necessary.

The session also explained the importance of preventing mosquito-borne diseases by ensuring that water does not accumulate around their homes. The children learned simple ways to protect themselves from mosquitoes and the importance of maintaining cleanliness in their surroundings.

Finally, the children were instructed to inform their parents, teachers, or a doctor immediately if they experienced symptoms such as fever, cough, cold, vomiting, diarrhea, or any other illness. They were also advised never to take medicines without adult supervision or medical advice. The primary objective of this awareness programme was to educate children about health, hygiene, and safety during the monsoon season and to encourage them to become responsible and safety-conscious individuals.



● KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS

On **26 July 2026**, Sneha Foundation organized a special awareness programme for children to commemorate **Kargil Vijay Diwas**. The main objective of the programme was to instill patriotism, national pride, and respect for the courage, bravery, and sacrifice of the Indian Armed Forces.

During the programme, the team explained the Kargil War in simple and easy-to-understand language. The children learned that in 1999, Pakistani intruders crossed into Indian territory in the Kargil region of Jammu and Kashmir. In response, the Indian Army launched Operation Vijay and displayed extraordinary courage and determination to defeat the enemy and successfully protect the nation's borders. India celebrates Kargil Vijay Diwas every year on 26 July to honour this historic victory.

The team also educated the children about the extraordinary sacrifices, dedication, and unwavering sense of duty demonstrated by Indian soldiers. Through inspiring examples, the children learned how the soldiers left behind their families and personal comforts to protect the nation. The programme encouraged the children to pay tribute to the martyrs and to remember their sacrifices with gratitude and respect.

The programme also highlighted the importance of the Indian National Flag, national unity, discipline, responsibility, and love for the country. The facilitators encouraged the students to practice honesty, hard work, discipline, and a spirit of service to the nation in their daily lives.

● **WORLD TIGER DAY AWARENESS PROGRAMME**

On **29 July 2026**, Sneha Foundation organized a **World Tiger Day** awareness programme for children. The main objective of the programme was to educate children about the importance of tigers in maintaining ecological balance, the need for wildlife conservation, and to develop a sense of love and responsibility toward nature.

During the programme, the facilitators explained in simple and engaging language that the tiger is the national animal of India and plays a vital role in maintaining the balance of forest ecosystems. They explained that a decline in the tiger population affects the entire food chain, which ultimately disturbs the ecological balance of nature.

The children learned that World Tiger Day is observed every year on 29 July to raise global awareness about tiger conservation and to inspire people to protect the rapidly declining tiger population. The session also highlighted that illegal hunting, deforestation, pollution, and the expansion of human settlements have severely affected the natural habitat of tigers.

The programme included many interesting facts about tigers. The children learned about the tiger's strength, hunting techniques, lifestyle, and its important role in the forest ecosystem. Using pictures and real-life examples, the facilitators explained that every living creature has an important role in nature and that protecting wildlife is the shared responsibility of all.

● LORD JAGANNATH RATH YATRA INFORMATION

The Rath Yatra, celebrated on the auspicious day of Ashadhi Beej, is one of India's most significant religious festivals and symbolizes devotion, faith, unity, and selfless service.

During the programme, the children were explained about the religious, cultural, and historical significance of the Rath Yatra in a simple and engaging manner. The children also learned about the history and traditions of the Rath Yatra of Lord Jagannath, his elder brother Balabhadra, and his sister Subhadraji, as well as their special significance in Indian culture and society.

● GURU PURNIMA CELEBRATION

On **29 July 2026**, Sneha Foundation organized a heartfelt and inspiring programme with children on the auspicious occasion of **Guru Purnima**. The main objective of the programme was to help children understand the importance of a Guru in life and to develop a sense of respect and gratitude towards their teachers, elders, and mentors.

The programme began with a prayer. Afterwards, the children were informed in simple language about why Guru Purnima is celebrated and about its religious and cultural significance. They were also told that Guru Purnima is celebrated as the birth anniversary of Maharishi Ved Vyasa. He compiled the Vedas, authored the great epic Mahabharata, and shared invaluable knowledge with society. Therefore, he is honoured as the Adi Guru (the first Guru).

During the programme, the children were taught that a Guru is not only a teacher who teaches in school, but anyone who shows the right path in life is also a Guru. Parents, teachers, elders, and every person who imparts good values in life are our Gurus. A Guru not only provides education but also inspires us to develop good values, discipline, honesty, hard work, and the ability to live a responsible life.

The children were introduced to the inspiring relationship between a Guru and a disciple through motivational stories. Special emphasis was placed on the fact that, with the guidance of teachers, a person can achieve success in life and earn a place as a responsible and respected citizen in society. The children were encouraged to always respect their Gurus, listen to them attentively, and follow their guidance throughout their lives.

During the programme, the children presented poems, thoughts, and inspiring stories about the greatness of a Guru. ADOLESCENCE PROJECT

Under the **Adolescence Project**, Sneha Foundation, with the support of **Dr. Hardikbhai Khatri**, distributed **sanitary pads** to **145** girls. Through the regular implementation of this project, all the girls associated with the Foundation have started using sanitary pads. As a result, the incidence of health problems among women has decreased, and the girls have become more aware of menstrual hygiene and personal health.
