► WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

On **5 June 2025**, Sneha Foundation celebrated **World Environment Day** at the institution. Children were taught about the importance of the environment – clean air, water, and land are essential for human life. They also learned the value of trees, the damage caused by plastic, and how to use reusable items through practical examples. The main objective of the program was to instill love, sensitivity, and responsibility towards the environment in children from a young age, so they grow up to become aware citizens.



► CHART ON THE SEVEN CONTINENTS OF THE EARTH

On **7 June 2025**, as part of holistic development activities at Sneha Foundation, children created a chart displaying information about the seven continents of the Earth. Through this, they were given detailed information.

There are seven continents on Earth: Asia, Africa, Europe, North America, South America, Antarctica, and Australia. Asia is the largest continent and includes countries like India, China, and Japan. Africa is the second-largest, home to the Sahara Desert and various unique wildlife species. Each continent has its own unique features and significance. The children were provided with various such informative insights.



► INFORMATION ABOUT GOOD HABITS AND BAD HABITS

On **20 June 2025**, under the all-round development activity at Sneha Foundation, children were informed about **good and bad habits by preparing a chart**. For the moral development of children, it is important that they understand the difference between good and bad behavior. In this session, children were taught virtues like speaking the truth, empathy, courage, etc. Along with this, they were also made aware of bad habits like miscommunication, lying, jealousy, bad behavior, and disrespect, and were taught to avoid them.

Through stories, pictures, scenes, and charts, children were inspired to adopt moral values in life through discussion and reflection. As a result, a positive change was observed in the behavior and thinking of the children, and they are growing up to become responsible citizens. Thus, the session on good and bad habits was conducted using charts to help children understand and develop morally and emotionally.



► INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

On **21 June 2025**, Sneha Foundation celebrated **International Yoga Day** at the institution. On this occasion, children practiced various yoga postures like Tadasana, Vrikshasana, Vajrasana, Padmasana, and Shirsasana. They were also taught the importance of yoga. Children actively participated and learned about the benefits of yoga such as good health, mental focus, and self-confidence. This program aimed to spread awareness about yoga among children and inspire them to lead a healthy life.



► ASHADHI BEEJ

On **26 June 2025**, a religious program was organized at Sneha Foundation on the auspicious occasion of **Ashadhi Beej**. Children were informed about why Ashadhi Beej is celebrated and its significance. Ashadhi Beej is a significant date associated mainly with Lord Krishna, Subhadra, and Balram, and is celebrated with devotion in many regions including Gujarat and Odisha.

Children were taught that on this day, Lord Jagannath, along with his brother Balram and sister Subhadra, embarks on a grand Rath Yatra. As every year, the deities are taken out of their temple and brought among devotees, which symbolizes devotion and surrender. It was also shared that the Rath Yatra from the Jagannath temple in Puri is world-famous, where thousands of devotees participate, and people from across the globe come for the darshan. This information was given to children to create awareness and pride in this cultural heritage.



ADOLESCENCE

Under the **Adolescence** Project operated by Sneha Foundation, **sanitary pads** were distributed to a total of **138** girls by **Dr. Hardikbhai Khatri**. Due to the regular implementation of this project, all the girls associated with the foundation are now using sanitary pads, which has led to a reduction in infection-related diseases in women and increased awareness among the girls.
