The education of students from class 1 to 9 continued as per the regular schedule, with a special focus on reading through various methods during the month of March, along with exam-oriented preparation.

Along with this, considering the upcoming exams for students of class 5 to 9, the organization conducted examinations for them. A parents meeting was also held to discuss the exams and student progress with their parents.



N. P. MEHTA PRIMARY SCHOOL REPORT

During the month of March, At the Sneha Foundation Managed N. P. Mehta Primary school the Sneha Foundation organized Bal Sabha every Saturday. Various activities were conducted for the children, including cultural performances, drama, monologues, children's songs, jokes, and riddles.

Additionally, special lectures were arranged to enhance students' reading, writing, recognition, and arithmetic skills. Teachers provided lessons based on the individual learning levels of the children. Students were also taught to read time, recognize shapes, colors, fruits, flowers, vegetables, and other objects. To develop observational skills, teachers placed various objects on two tables for children to classify and describe. Furthermore, sensory activities such as blindfolded tasting and smelling were conducted to enhance their perception.

To keep students updated with technology, computer education was also provided. Children were introduced to essential computer components such as the mouse, keyboard, CPU, monitor, hardware, and software.

Considering the annual examinations, a parents meeting was organized during the month. Discussions were held on important topics, such as limiting children's excessive phone usage, ensuring parental supervision at home, encouraging punctuality during exams, and taking necessary precautions for their well-being.

> FIRE SAFETY TRAINING

On 16 March 2025, students of The Sneha Foundation received information on Fire Safety, along with practical demonstrations for better understanding.

Such programs help students gain knowledge about different types of fires, fire control methods, the use of fire extinguishers, and ways to stay safe during emergencies. Through practical training, they were taught how to remain calm and act wisely in real-life fire situations.

Additionally, students were educated on what to do if a fire breaks out at home, school, or any other place. They were advised to stay calm, avoid panic, move away from the source of fire, and find a safe exit. They learned to open doors cautiously, look for alternative escape routes if there was smoke or heat, and evacuate safely if the fire spread further. They were also instructed to inform the fire brigade immediately.





INTERNATIONAL FOREST DAY

"Save the Environment, Keep Forests Alive"

On 21 March 2025, The Sneha Foundation organized a program to celebrate International Forest Day. During this event, children were provided with detailed information about the importance of forests, wildlife conservation, and various ways to protect the environment.

Throughout the program, children were engaged with interesting stories about the lifestyle of wild animals. They were also educated on the consequences of deforestation and its significant impact on the environment. Additionally, they received guidance on simple steps to contribute to forest conservation.

The primary objective of this initiative by Sneha Foundation was to nurture awareness and sensitivity towards nature among future generations. The organization aims to continue conducting such meaningful programs in the future to promote environmental awareness.





WORLD WATER DAY

On 22 March 2025, The Sneha Foundation organized a program to commemorate World Water Day, emphasizing water conservation, glacier-river preservation, and environmental awareness.

During the event, the teachers of Sneha Foundation educated children about their social responsibility in water conservation. They provided valuable insights into rainwater management and maintenance in flat and housing societies, as well as the importance of conducting awareness campaigns. To reinforce the significance of water, children participated in a plantation drive and took a pledge to conserve water.





► MARTYRS' DAY

On 23 March 2025, Sneha Foundation observed Martyrs' Day by educating children about the sacrifices of India's immortal heroes and paying tribute to their bravery.

The children were introduced to the courageous stories of revolutionaries such as Bhagat Singh, Rajguru, Sukhdev, and Chandra Shekhar Azad through their portraits and inspiring narratives. Additionally, a patriotic discourse was conducted, allowing students to express their feelings of nationalism.
