

During the school vacation, the foundation organized a special learning program for academically weak children especially those struggling with reading and writing in Gujarati. These children were given focused practice in reading, writing, and arithmetic.

The summer camp was held at N. P. Mehta Primary School, managed by Sneha Foundation, during the summer holidays. A total of 387 students from class 1 to 10 enthusiastically participated.

The camp featured a variety of activities including sports, craft workshops, drawing competitions, block printing, and "best out of waste." Each day focused on a different theme or skill-based activity to promote creative learning.

The main objective was to provide a proper platform for students to develop various skills such as literature, arts, sports, and life skills in addition to academic knowledge. Summer Camp 2025 proved to be a memorable educational and entertaining experience for such students. By integrating games, art and culture, this camp was very beneficial for the overall development of the children.

On the last day of the summer camp, appreciation certificates were given to students who participated in all activities, and special prizes were awarded for excellent work.

GUJARAT FOUNDATION DAY

On 1 May 2025, Gujarat Foundation Day was celebrated at N. P. Mehta Primary School run by Sneha Foundation. An informative session was organized with the aim of making students aware of the history of Gujarat.

During the program, students were given detailed information about the Maha Gujarat Movement, including why the movement started, who the key leaders were, and the contributions of the martyrs who lost their lives during the movement. In addition, information was also provided about the structure of the Gujarat state, the proposal of its formation, and the core elements of its development.

RABINDRANATH TAGORE'S BIRTH ANNIVERSARY

On 7 May 2025, on the occasion of Rabindranath Tagore's birth anniversary, Sneha Foundation explained to the children briefly about his life and work. Rabindranath Tagore was a great poet, writer, painter, and educationist. He was the first Indian to receive the Nobel Prize in Literature. He wrote the national anthem "Jana Gana Mana", and in the Shantiniketan School founded by him, great importance was given to value-based education.

The children were shown that Tagore's creations carry the message of humanity, love, and freedom.

At the end of the program, inspirational incidents from his life were presented.





BEST OUT OF WASTE

On 10 May 2025, under holistic development activities by Sneha Foundation, a Best out of Waste activity was conducted. Children creatively used plastic cups to prepare various items. These activities helped the children develop a new perspective that even waste can be useful. If we think and imagine, useful things can be created even from waste.








ADOLESCENCE
